Tissue Paper Sun Catchers

Social: 1.6.Co-operating

Materials:

- Tissue paper in various colours
- Scissors
- White glue or liquid starch
- Paint brush
- Metal pie pan/ Wax paper
- Double-sided tape



Method:

- Think of the sun catcher you wish to make and chose the tissue paper colour accordingly. For example for the sun you will need yellow, red, orange, and white.
- 2. Dilute the white glue 4:1.
- 3. Give your child a metal pie pan or wax paper and have him brush the glue mixture all over the bottom the pan.
- 4. Tear the sheets of tissue paper into small pieces or cut into the 1" squares.
- 5. Place the squares on top of the glue mixture, brushing glue on the tissue paper as needed to stick.
- 6. When the bottom of the pan is completely covered with tissue paper, brush on a final layer of the glue mixture.
- 7. Allow the tissue paper to dry overnight, and then carefully peel the mosaics of tissue paper out of the pan.
- 8. If you like you can cut the paper into a specific shape if you want.
- 9. Punch a hole at the top of the sun catcher and thread a ribbon though it.
- 10. Hang your child's Sun Catcher in a window.
