MILK CARTON BIRD FEEDER

2.3 Self Esteem – showing pride in work and achievements, 2.6 Positive Attitudes towards Learning, such as persistence, engagement, and curiosity – increasing pride in work and interest in learning new things.

Materials Needed:

- ✓ Milk carton or milk jug
- ✓ Paint, glue, stickers, popsicle sticks, twigs etc. Be creative and use what you have at home!
- ✓ String or rope
- ✓ Bird Seed (I know many of you won't have this handy, so wait to fill your bird feeder after your next grocery run or delivery!)

How to make your bird feeder:

- 1. Acquire a simple, 2 litre-size milk cartons. Empty it completely, and wipe to dry. Milk can mold with the bird feed.
- 2. Get some scissors and cut a quarter-sized hole in the milk carton. You may want to make a bigger opening, depending on ease and the possibilities of other animals enjoying the birds' food.
- 3. Add a stick by taping or gluing it to the bottom of the hole.
- 4. Decorate your bird feeder.
- 5. Fill it up with bird seed, or bird-appropriate food.

Tips

- Make the hole small enough for a bird, and not a squirrel
- Don't over-fill the carton so food spills out for rodents etc.
- Get help from an adult with the cutting if you need help
