Supplies:

- Magnetic Alphabet
- Cookie baking sheet
- Dark blue or black construction paper
- Plastic bin
- Small Lego or other toys or sand
- Tape

Magnet stick (optional)

Directions:

- Cut out a piece of dark coloured construction paper to fit the inside of the cookie sheet.
- 2. Tape the sheet of paper on to the cookie sheet so it stays in place.
- 3. Place the magnetic letters on top of the paper slightly apart from each other in order.
- 4. Put the cookie sheet in direct sunlight for 2 hours or longer.
- 5. Once the sun has bleached the letters enough for the letters to show up clearly, remove it from the sunlight.
- Move the magnetic letters from the cookie sheet and let your child observe the sun-bleached result.
- 7. Mix the letters with small Legos or other small objects in the plastic bin.
- 8. Your child can then treasure hunt the letters and match them up to the letters on the cookie sheet.

 You may offer your child a magnet stick to attract the letters while treasure hunting.

Tips:

- You may help your child identify the letters before the matching game as needed.
- You can also read an alphabet story book with your child together before the activity.
- You may use other toys to do more sun bleach experiment with your child.
