Description of Activity:

Before beginning with the painting, set up an area with tablecloth or newspaper to prevent making a mess.

- 1. Children can then begin taping on the canvas in any designs they want. They can do random stripes, letters of their name, or in a shape of any objects.
- 2. Make sure to press the edges of the tape design down securely to prevent paint from seeping underneath.
- 3. Paint over the entire canvas using the colors they want. Afterward, let the painting sit and dry.
- 4. After the paints are completely dried, children can lift up the tape to see the design they have made.

Supplies Needed:

- Canvas/painting paper (Any size, depends on how much the child wants to paint)
- Paint brushes
- Acrylic paint/washable paint/watercolor/pastel
- Painter's tape
- Sharpies (optional)
