**Clothing**

As the seasons change, your child should be appropriately dressed for the weather. We continue to go outdoors unless there is an extreme weather alert. Children are very busy and can get messy in their activities at times. Please dress your child in clothing that is comfortable, simple to get on and off and can be "messed up".

**Footwear**

Safe footwear is extremely important. Please ensure that your child has closed toe, non-slip shoes always. We do not allow open toe shoes or sandals. Running shoes are preferred because of their very active physical play both indoors and outdoors.
